As a young paramedic in the early 80's, I earned my stripes running calls and providing emergency medical care in the Ojai Valley. At the time, our Emergency Department was just a single room with two beds separated by curtains, and our community's family practice physicians rotated ER call.

Even in the 80's — long before our emergency room expansion, hospital remodel, and eventual Continuing Care Center project — there was talk of our hospital purchasing the Lutheran Church property next door. In 2005, mention of acquiring the property was documented at one of the first Ojai Valley Hospital Foundation Board meetings, and it's been on our minds ever since.

Thanks to the generosity of donors like you — almost 20 years later in October 2024 — that dream became a reality.

This milestone property acquisition marks the fulfillment of a long-time goal of the Ojai Valley Hospital Foundation — to pave the way for the future of healthcare in the Ojai Valley and provide our hospital leaders with the flexibility to plan for the future of our community.

But our work is just beginning.

Community Memorial Hospital – Ojai meets crucial needs in our community — the need for life-saving emergency treatment right here in the valley; the need for long-term rehabilitative care close to the support of friends and loved ones; and the need for easy access to healthcare services like lab tests, routine imaging, and infusions.

When Hugh reported a sudden tightness in his chest to his wife, Lindsay, she wasted no time and drove him directly to Community Memorial Hospital in Ojai. The Emergency Room team recognized Hugh's symptoms as signs of a heart attack and immediately whisked him away for an EKG, which confirmed their suspicions. Within minutes. Hugh was stabilized and loaded into the back of an ambulance with Leif — one of Ojai's highly experienced ER nurses — for transport to our sister hospital in Ventura.
